What is SSS?

What is a Learning Group?

Learning Groups are small groups of first-year students who meet weekly with an upperclassman to learn about college success, academic skills and leadership development.

All first-year students in the SSS program will be assigned a Learning Group based on their class schedule. Weekly attendance is required.
